MARDI GRAS HOLIDAYS – There will be no school next week, February 12 – 16, for the Mardi Gras holidays. Classes will resume on Monday, February 19.

IN-SCHOOL REGISTRATION – In-School Registration for returning students and their siblings for the 2018 – 2019 school year ends this Friday, February 9th. Registration forms & tuition rates have been posted on the school's website. Registration fee is \$175 for the first child and \$160 for each additional child in the family. **After February 9th, the registration fee increases to \$225 PER CHILD.** If you need a registration form (long form) for a child in your family who will be new to AOL for the 18-19 school year, call the office.

1ST RECONCILIATION – First Reconciliation will be held after 6:00 Mass on Wednesday, February 7th. Students who will be celebrating the sacrament of Reconciliation are encouraged to attend 6:00 Mass, but should be at the church no later than 6:15 PM. These children are to wear “church clothes” and will be sitting with their Religion teacher at the front of the church. Families are encouraged to attend.

PRE-K PARADE – The PreK's Mardi Gras parade will be held this Friday immediately after the school Mass (approximately 9:15). Parents are welcome to join us!

BOOK FAIR – You are invited to our Cavalier House Book Fair which will be held this week, Wednesday - Friday. A schedule for when classes will visit is being sent home today.

TREAT SALE – The 1st Grade will sell treats for 50¢ each at all lunches on Friday, February 9.
